Integrative Medicine: A Clinician's Journal (IMCJ) Conflict of Interest Form

In keeping with the guidelines established February 2006 by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (*Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals*), *IMCJ* decrees the following:

Conflict of interest exists when an author (or the author's institution or company) has financial or personal relationships that inappropriately influence (bias) his or her actions (such relationships are also known as dual commitments, competing interests, or competing loyalties). These relationships vary from those with negligible potential to those with great potential to influence judgment, and not all relationships represent true conflict of interest. The potential for conflict of interest can exist whether or not an individual believes that the relationship affects his or her scientific judgment.

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
